Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our 'Come Outside' topic, Ash & Oak classes will be going on a full day trip to visit the Carymoor Environmental Education Centre <https://www.carymoor.org.uk/> on Wednesday 11th May. We will be taking part in a 'Wild Day Out' at the centre and explore the extensive range of habitats and wildlife there through a range of exciting activities. This will help the children gain a deeper understanding of the natural world and appreciation of its wonders.

The coach will leave school promptly at 9.00am and we will be back to school by the end of the school day at 3.00pm. The children will need to wear a school jumper or cardigan with trousers, socks and sensible shoes or boots suitable for walking. They will also need:

- A sun hat and sun lotion applied before school.
- A waterproof coat.
- A packed lunch and a drink bottle, both in a backpack.

Our Charging policy:

All contributions are voluntary. If we do not receive sufficient voluntary contributions, we may cancel a trip. The cost for the event is £12.50 and you can make payment on ParentMail now and give your consent for your child to go on the trip. If you prefer to pay by cash, you can print a PayPoint barcode from ParentMail or collect one from the front desk at school.
