We will start to focus on our leavers play, learning songs, giving out parts and rehearsing.

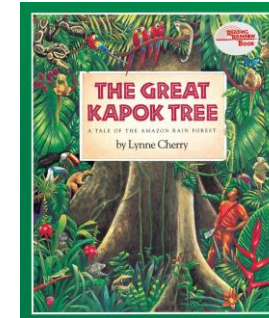
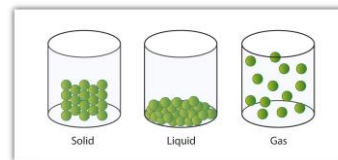
As musicians, we will be looking at a unit of work from Charanga called ‘Blackbird’ as well learning the songs for our leavers play.
