As **Artists** we will be creating our own Pop Art mixed media portrait of our own super hero/heroine.


As **Geographers** we will learn to create birds-eye view maps of our school and the local area.

As **Historians** we will be learning about the lives of significant individuals from the past. We will explore the lives of the nurses, Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale.




As **Writers** we will be learning to use adjectives to describe characters and settings. We will focus on using capital letters and full stops and question marks in our sentences. We will use connectives **and, but and because** to join phrases to make sentences longer. We will also design our own characters and write a story about what happens when they meet Traction Man!

In **Maths** we will continue our addition and subtraction learning journey, solving addition and subtraction up to 100 with 2-digit numbers. We will also learn to solve word problems.
