


Year 3 Willow and Rowan



English

We will develop our knowledge and understanding of Spelling Punctuation and Grammar through the discrete teaching of different concepts, including the use of adjectives and verbs.

Our weekly spellings will focus on common exception words and children will write out their spellings for the week each Friday and bring them home to learn We will also do will do daily practice of these at school. These will be checked each Friday in school.



We will complete some extended writing including writing a newspaper report based on events in Pompeii in August AD79.

Times tables

The children will continue to learn their 3 times tables, before moving onto learning the 4 times table. These should be practised at home daily if possible. The children can learn them in many ways including "TTRockstars", for which they have passwords. There are also many great songs on Youtube to which they can sing along to help learn the tables.

Geography

We will learn about locational knowledge, focusing on Europe and the United Kingdom. We will also look at physical features including volcanoes and in particular Mount Vesuvius.

We will also explore measure and will learn how to convert centimeters into millimetres and metres.
