<p>ENGLISH</p> <p>During English, we will look at a range of different poem styles so that we can write our own.</p> <p>The children will learn a poem and recite it to the class.</p> <p>We will read 'Gregory Cool' and use this to compare and contrast Trinidad & Tobago with England. Letter writing will be a focus using this text.</p> <p>We will explore the text 'The Great Kapok Tree' and start to learn about deforestation - looking at the arguments for and against the process.</p>	<p>MATHS</p> <p>During Maths, we will use fraction learning to learn and understand decimals – tenths and hundredths and converting from fractions e.g $0.25 = \frac{1}{4}$. This will link into work around money, adding amounts and finding change.</p> <p>We will also bring in learning and refining how to tell the time.</p> <p>We will also continue to practise our times tables.</p>	<p>ART</p> <p>In Art, we will be investigating repeating patterns, looking at the artist Rousseau to create a leaf design for printing as well as close observational drawings.</p> <p>SCIENCE</p> <p>We will be learning about the stages of the Water Cycle and link this to our geography work.</p> <p>PSHE/JIGSAW</p> <p>Our theme to begin with this term is about our 'Relationships'.</p>
