# How we will communicate with you:

# **Urgent communications**

If your child is unwell or there is another urgent matter concerning your child, we will ring the contacts on your child's pupil record in order. Please make sure that we always have an up to date number that will be available throughout the day.

# ParentMail

ParentMail is our main communication and online payment system. We use this service to send out whole school, year group and individual communications, to notify you about any school closures and to take online payments.

Download the free ParentMail app now, so you can see all your school communications, payments and bookings in one place.

# Newsletters

The St John's Journal is published once per month and is sent out to parents through ParentMail as well as being available on the school website.

# **Individual letters**

These will be about specific information you need to have or details of specific events. These will not always be whole school letters; they will often be just for a single year group. They will be written and emailed to you through ParentMail as and when required. All individual letters will also be published on the school website.
