SEESAW

We have recently reviewed how we are using our remote learning and communication platform, Seesaw. When we introduced the system, we used child remote learning codes to enable children to complete learning activities on Seesaw. Now we don't need to provide regular remote learning, we are using Seesaw as a way to communicate with families about their child's learning each week. As such, we have changed the way you access the system, so you are accessing it as a 'family member' rather than as your child. If you have more than one child at the school, you will be able to switch more easily between children and see records from previous years as well as the current year.

Please click the link sent out recently on your ParentMail. The same link can be used for both parents to set up accounts but please note we can only approve access for those with parental responsibility for the child.
