# **ENVIRONMENT WEEK**



At the start of this half term, we had a whole school 'Environment Week'. Each class took part in different activities, including upcycling plastic bottles and tin cans to make 'bee hotels', pencil cases, bird feeders and plant pots, rock painting, planting seeds, crafting bees, and junk modelling.

Children in Years 3 and 4 also went to the woods behind the Cheese and Grain with Jo and Helen from Frome Town Council as part of the 'Wild About Frome' project. They made pictures of trees using natural materials - collecting different colours by rubbing leaves and flowers onto a paper artist's pallet, then they did a bug hunt and used the app 'Seek' to identify what they found.

They also took time simply to stand in silence, listening to the sounds of nature all around them.



#### **HAPPINESS HUNT**

Children in Year 4 went on a really special trip to Rowden House - the residential home we are linked with as part of 'The Happiness Hunt' project - finally meeting the residents who Maple class have been writing to, and making things for, over the last year. Happiness Hunt organisers had arranged a garden party at Rowden House, during which residents and children sang songs and read poems for each other, chatted, did a craft activity and shared this amazing cake!

#### **CLASSES NEXT YEAR**

# TRANSFER DAYS - FRIDAY 1<sup>ST</sup> AND WEDNESDAY 6<sup>TH</sup> JULY

We are having two transition days to give children two opportunities to spend full days with their new teachers. The first will just be happening at St John's, the second happens across Frome and Year 4 will spend the day at their new school. The arrangements for each day are as follows:

# Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July

All children need to come into school through their usual doors and go to their current classrooms for registration. We will then have Headteacher Awards and classes will leave with their new teachers who will take them to their new classrooms. At the end of the day children will be dismissed from the location for their new class (see below).
